The first phase of our project consisted in identifying successful models and case studies of personcentered care from each of the partner countries as well as an EU level based on information collected from semi-structured interviews and focus groups.

Seven themes emerged from the analisys of the transcriptions: care practices followed by the organisation, cooperation and coordination of multidisciplinary teams, communication and use of person-centred language, involment of the person and their family in the decision-making process, inclusivity and accessibility of care services for dependent people, monitoring and evaluation tools for care services, barriers and solutions to problems in person-centred care.


